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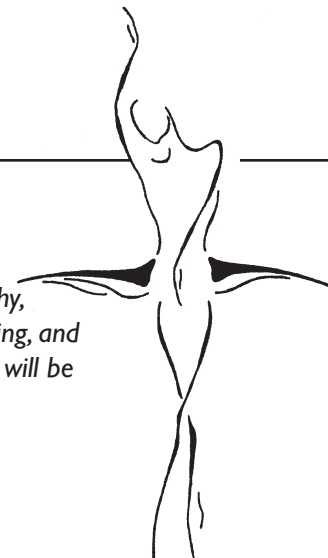
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Summer Intensive Program

Recommended for everyone in Ballet III/IV/Company. Take as many classes as you wish, up to 10 classes per week, over six weeks. This valuable program is offered at a very competitive rate of **\$625** for the six-week program, and is available to current and new students. An additional discount of \$50 is offered for early registration and payment by May 14, 2008.

The Summer Intensive Program has both a minimum and a maximum number of participants to ensure the most effective student/teacher ratios and a high quality of instruction. **Please register early to avoid disappointment.**

Summer Intensive Program for fewer than the full six weeks costs **\$150 per week**. We offer a discount of \$25 per week with early registration and payment by May 14, so the fee for early registrants becomes **\$125 per week**.

With the unlimited Summer Intensive Program, you can take up to 60 classes this summer for as little as \$575, equivalent to an average cost per class of only about \$9.50. You will have the flexibility to take as many or as few classes as you wish each week, and you will be supporting the VDT and our teaching staff in the production of this incredible summer program.
